

Fondation Centre Pompadour – Public Statutes

Summary

1. Name and Seat

The Fondation Centre Pompadour – Stiftung zur Förderung feministischer Agenden – is a non-profit private foundation with its registered seat in Vienna, Austria.

2. Purpose of the Foundation

The purpose of the Foundation is the advancement of feminist agendas in the fields of science, art, culture, media, and public welfare. This includes the promotion, research, and dissemination of feminist thought (with particular emphasis on the principles of the female gaze), gender equality across all areas of life, and the support of initiatives countering sexist or discriminatory structures.

3. Beneficiaries

The Foundation serves the general public within the meaning of its purpose. Individuals, institutions, and projects aligned with the feminist objectives of the Foundation may be eligible for support.

4. Types of Support & Use of Funds

The Foundation pursues its purpose primarily through:

- Grants, scholarships, awards, and financial support for eligible projects
 - Collaborations with cultural and educational institutions
 - Transparent and criteria-based funding procedures in accordance with applicable regulations
- Funds are used exclusively to support feminist projects and activities.

5. Governing Bodies

The Foundation's governing bodies are:

- The Board of Directors
- The Advisory Council

The names of the members may be published without private addresses.

6. Transparency and Accountability

The Foundation operates on a non-profit basis under Austrian law. Annual activity reports and financial summaries may be made publicly available to ensure transparency regarding the Foundation's work and allocation of funds.
